Subject: PLNP2014-00074. 21st Amendment Liquor ABC License Hearing To Determine Whether Public Convenience Would Be Served By Issuance Of A Liquor License To 21st Amendment Liquor Store Located At 1555 Fulton Avenue, Suite A, Sacramento, CA 95825

Overview

The Board of Supervisors (Board) hears requests for public convenience/necessity (PCN) applications for liquor licenses within the unincorporated area, prior to issuance of a license by the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) if the site is located within an over-concentrated census tract or a specified high crime reporting district. The applicant, who currently owns a Type 21 license and operates 21st Amendment Liquor Store at 1120 Fulton Avenue, requests an Off-Sale General (Type 21) license on Fulton Avenue, between Arden Way and Wittkop Way (previously a Pier One Imports store). The site is located in a sector designated as high crime by the Sheriff's Department (Sheriff), based on 2013 crime statistics and, if approved, will be located in a census tract that has an over-concentration of Off-Sale liquor licenses (Type 20 and Type 21) as set by ABC. The Sheriff will withdraw their opposition to the issuance of an additional liquor license in the census tract if all the conditions listed in their letter dated June 4, 2014 (Attachment 1) are met. The Arden Arcade Community Planning Advisory Council (CPAC) recommends approval (5-0 with all members present).

Recommendation

Make a Finding of Public Convenience for a Type 21 liquor license for 21st Amendment Liquor Store located on Fulton Avenue, between Arden Way and Wittkop Way.

Measures/Evaluation

The success of this decision can be measured by applying conditions for operations.

Fiscal Impact

Costs are covered by application fees.

BACKGROUND

The applicant comes to the County pursuant to the provisions of the Business and Professions Code Sections 23958 and 23958.4, which provide that the ABC shall deny an application for an on-sale/off-sale license if “issuance of that license would tend to create a law enforcement problem, or if issuance would result in or add to an undue concentration of licenses.” The present formula for determining excess licenses within the same census tract is based upon one on-sale license per population of 947 within the census tract and one off-sale license per population of 1,524 within the census tract.

The Board has adopted a process for receiving applications, noticing of a public hearing by the Clerk and review of the applications. This process, as specified by the State, requires a letter from the Sheriff to be sent within 15 days that typically requests standard conditions be applied. The Board’s findings of Convenience are based on these standard conditions, which will be applied by ABC on the license. The Board can also choose to deny the request.

DISCUSSION

21st Amendment Liquor Store which has been in business for 30 years is applying for an Off-Sale General (Type 21) license at 1555 Fulton Avenue, between Arden Way and Wittkop Way, in the Arden Arcade Community (Attachment 2). The justification letter (Attachment 3) is provided.

The owners of 21st Amendment Liquor Store recently purchased the site at 1155 Fulton Avenue, which was previously a Pier 1 Import Store. The new owners are planning to divide the building into four suites. The liquor/convenience store will be located in Suite A. The owners are proposing to relocate their existing Type 21 license located at 1120 Fulton Avenue (leased space) to this site which requires them to apply for a new PCN because the new location is in a different census tract. The new store will occupy approximately 3,000 square feet and the amount of shelf space and cooler area devoted to beer, wine, and liquor will be less than 25 percent of the floor area.

Analysis related to over-concentration. The requested license location is within Census Tract 55.06. The existing store is in Census Tract 56.06 (Attachment 4). Based on the population standard at the time of application, Census Tract 55.06 permits two off-sale licenses and there are currently six existing within the tract. The approval of this PCN will be the seventh establishment to sell off-sale alcohol within the census boundaries and the tract would continue to be in the over-concentrated category. In addition to the standard analysis by Census Tract, staff included a map showing all Type 20 and Type 21 licenses within a one-mile radius (Attachment 4). There are a total of 23 establishments that sell alcohol in this radius, 12 Type 20 and 11 Type 21.

Analysis related to crime. State law requires that if a liquor license is proposed to be located within a crime reporting district which exceeds the average for all such reporting districts within the jurisdiction by 20 percent, a finding of public convenience is required from the local governing entity. Census Tract 55.06 is shown as a high crime area based on the Sheriff’s 2013 crime maps.

Conditions. Conditions will be placed on both the Sheriff’s letter to the ABC and the business license. Both sets of conditions (referenced below) are necessary due to the individual enforcement power of ABC and the County of Sacramento.

Sheriff’s Department Conditions:

- Maintain parking lot and ground free of litter

- Post signage – no loitering
- Post signage – no open container on premises or sidewalk

Business License Conditions:

- Security cameras shall be placed on the interior and exterior of the building. The tapes shall be kept for a minimum of 60 days. Operator shall register cameras in the Sacramento County Sheriff database.
- All inflatable/portable/A-frame signs are prohibited
- All Sacramento Development Code standards including parking, fencing, signage and landscaping shall apply

Security Measures. 21st Amendment Liquor trains all cashiers and managers to sell alcohol in compliance with California law. There are security cameras strategically placed on the alcohol displays and throughout the interior and exterior of the store. The new store location will have increased security at the rear of the property.

All surveillance footage will be saved for a minimum of six months and made available to the Sheriff's Department upon request. The parking lot is designed to be well lit which should discourage loitering. All of the above items will be placed as conditions on the business license.

Following are additional comments and recommendations:

A. Community Planning Advisory Council (CPAC):

This application was referred to the Arden Arcade CPAC and heard on July 24, 2014. Planning staff and the applicant both gave presentations. The members were advised that 21st Amendment Liquor has been in the Sacramento region for over thirty years and has been working with the Sheriff and the community. The CPAC members voted 5-0 (all members present) to recommend approval to the Board (Attachment 5).

B. Environmental Management Department - Environmental Health Division:

The Environmental Health Division had no negative comments about this application, nor any recorded history of problems with the applicant.

C. Treasurer-Tax Collector - Business Licensing Division:

The applicant has a current Business License (GNB32006-27595) and Tobacco License (TRB12006-50533). The applicant will have to reapply for new licenses with the change of location.

D. Sheriff's Department:

In his letter dated June 4, 2014, the Sheriff agreed to withdraw his opposition if the applicant agrees to the conditions listed in the letter.

Conclusion

Board approval of a PCN application is necessary due to high crime and over-concentration. The approval of this application would result in the census tract exceeding the maximum number of off-sale licenses by three. The Sheriff recommends withdrawal of their opposition if standard conditions are placed on the license. The applicant is in agreement with all conditions listed on the

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Sheriff's letter. The CPAC has recommended approval and their comments are attached. Despite the change in conditions, staff is relying heavily on the Sheriff's recommendation and the fact that the CPAC was made aware of such recommendations. Staff, therefore, recommends approval of this application for a Finding of Public Convenience.

Mr. Mejia,

The Sacramento County Sheriff's Department notified the California Department of Alcohol, Beverage control of it's decision to not protest the request for a premise to premise transfer of **21st AMENDMENT LIQUOR, 1555 FULTON AVE, FILE #542563.**

The Sacramento County Sheriff's Department has requested the following conditions be placed on the business,

1. The applicant shall be responsible for maintaining the parking area and exterior grounds free of litter and the adjacent sidewalk to the premise over which they have control.
2. Licensee(s) shall post and maintain on the premises and in the parking lot used in conjunction therewith, notices or signs, no less than eighteen inches by twenty-four inches (18" x 24") in size, clearly visible to patrons of the licensee(s) and parking lot and to persons on the public sidewalk stating in two (2) inch block lettering the following:

NO LOITERING IS ALLOWED ON OR IN FRONT OF THESE PREMISES

3. Licensee(s) shall post and maintain on the premises and in the parking lot used in conjunction therewith, notices or signs no less than eighteen inches by twenty-four inches (18"x 24") in size, clearly visible to patrons of the licensee(s) and parking lot and to persons on the public sidewalk stating in two(2) inch block lettering the following:

**UNLAWFUL TO ENTER, BE OR REMAIN ON ADJACENT PARKING LOT OR
ADJACENT PUBLIC SIDEWALK WITH AN OPEN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE
CONTAINER. BP 25612.5 PC 647e (a); SCC 9.92.202**

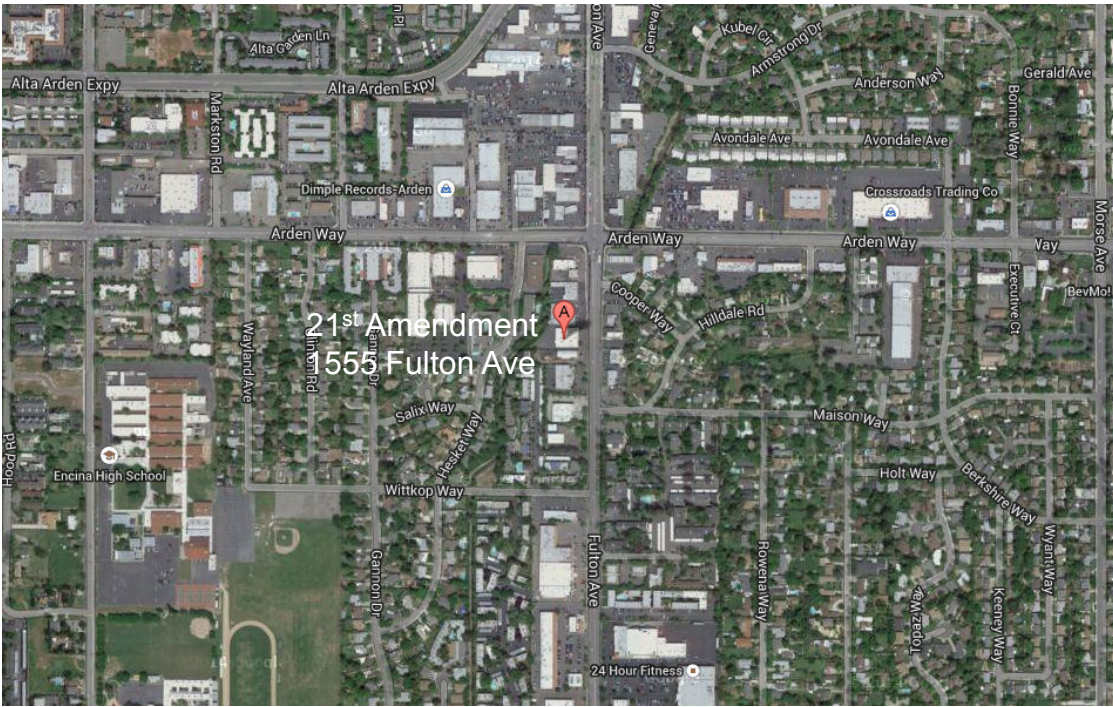

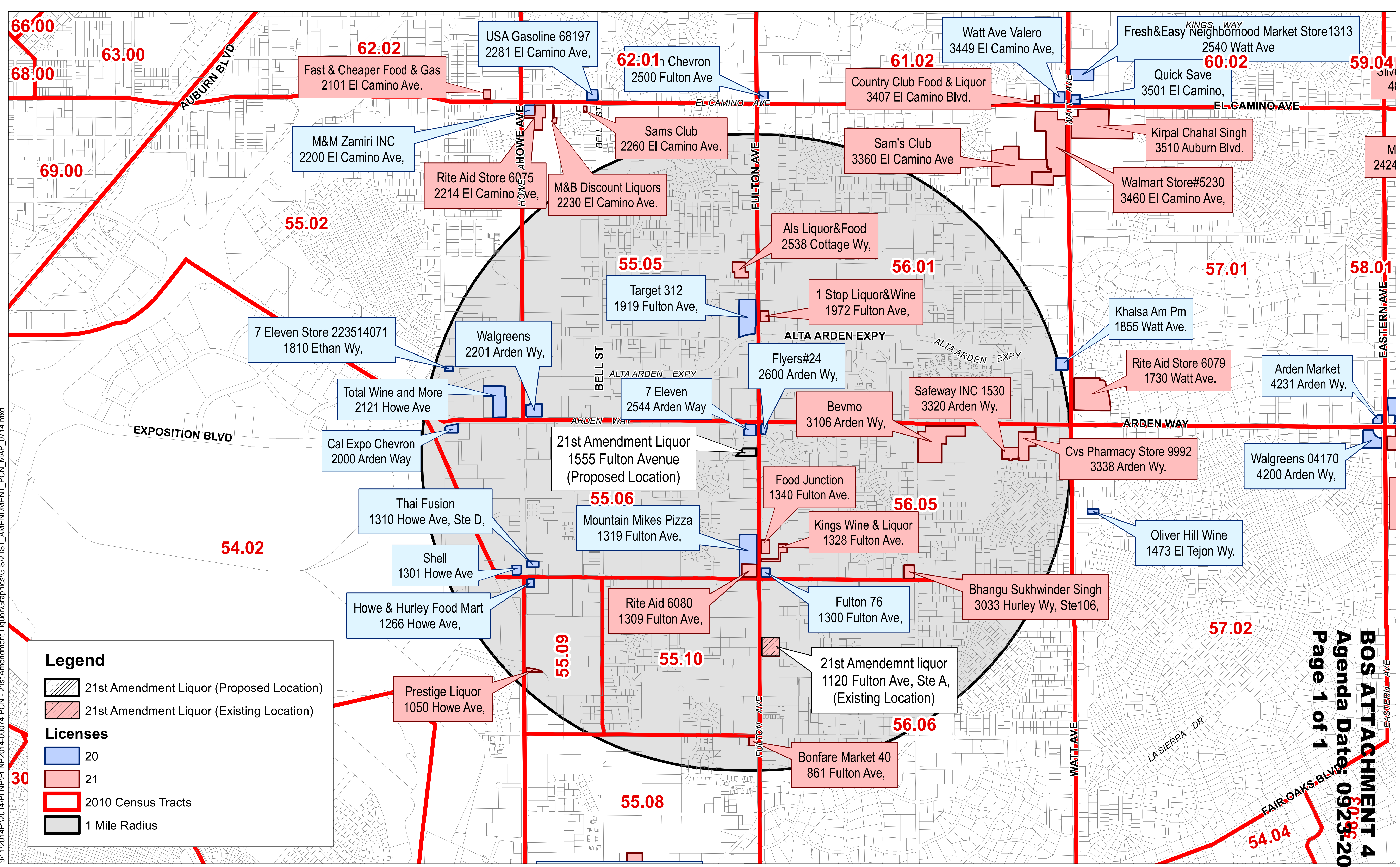


