

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

NOTICE is hereby given that a draft Environmental Assessment (EA) has been prepared by the County of Sacramento pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act, and is available for public review.

TITLE: PROPOSED EVA AIR FLIGHT TRAINING ACADEMY AT SACRAMENTO MATHER AIRPORT – Environmental Assessment

LOCATION:

Sacramento Mather Airport is located approximately 12 miles east of downtown Sacramento in the unincorporated portion of Sacramento County, south of the City of Rancho Cordova. The 9.66 acre project site is located on the airport at the southeast corner of the intersection of Whitehead Street and Macready Avenue.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Proposed EVA Air Flight Training Academy would conduct pilot training using small general aviation aircraft. The project would entail demolition of an existing office building, two former bombsight storage buildings, and one aircraft maintenance hangar at Mather Airport. In addition, the following facilities would be constructed:

- An 18,000 square-foot, single-story, office/classroom building
- Fifteen (15) open T-shed canopies for aircraft storage
- A 50,000 square-foot, 110-room, four-story dormitory building
- A 6,000 square-foot, single-story cafeteria building
- A 16,000 square-foot, single-story maintenance hangar
- Landscaping and parking improvements (30 spaces)
